



Environmental and Energy Policy

Corialis recognises that environmental degradation and climate change is a significant global problem. As a business we are committed to the prevention and protection of the environment. We believe that our corporate responsibility goes beyond proprietary borders. Corialis ensures fulfilment of our applicable compliance obligations. However, we consider this to be a bare minimum. We endeavour to go beyond the status quo and see techniques and approaches that position us ahead of our competition.

The key material of our products is aluminium, which is infinitely recyclable. In order to promote sustainable consumption we are obtaining Cradle2Cradle™ certification for our architectural systems across all hubs. Next to the recyclability, we continue to invest in research and development to improve the quality of our products which enhances the quality of living and environmental performance, e.g. by having better insulation values. Furthermore, our products are designed to be low maintenance and not to require aggressive cleaning products; as well as being able to be refurbished or upgraded in terms of hardware and glazing.

Management has set up the organisation of the company targeting a minimal environment impact with fully vertically integrated production sites, resulting in lower transportation requirements. We also support local economies and communities by procuring goods and services locally when possible.

Corialis acknowledges this is a process of continual improvement with regard to environmental performance and energy management. At this point in time, Corialis is expanding and harmonizing its environmental reporting. This environmental reporting will allow us to set objectives and targets, to enable impact of our efforts to be measured. We commit to ensure that information and resources necessary to achieve established objectives and targets will be available.

We seek to obtain relevant ISO certification, such as ISO14001 and ISO50001, for all production sites and their related transport activities. We acknowledge that our operations have an impact on the environment. Hence, we support the procurement of energy efficient products, services, and process design. In addition, we have taken initiatives to reduce this impact and we will keep taking similar initiatives, including but not limited to:

- Installing renewable energy sources;
- Applying most environmental friendly techniques, such as chrome free powder coating instead of using liquid paint;
- Reduce water consumption and implement new technologies for water recuperation;
- Scrubbing of air and vapours;
- Eliminate packaging wherever possible or use recyclable packaging;
- Separate waste streams and engage in maximum recyclability.
